The program was sponsored by the Wilson County Veterans, the City of Lebanon and Wilson County.

After the impressive event the General Robert Hatton members conducted a brief business session and welcomed new member Ada Midgett with a luncheon and a new member cake. The 21 chapter awards that were earned at the October State Convention were shared with the members. The chapter's outstanding efforts for Veterans were recognized as follows for medium size chapters: First Place—Most Money Donated to Veteran's Causes; First Place—Total Dollar Value of Items Donated to Veterans; First Place—Most Cards/letters sent to hospitalized Veterans; First Place—Number of Cancelled Stamps Sent to Veteran's Services; and First Place—Number of Cards/letters mailed to Active Duty Military Personnel. Among the other awards received were: Benevolent—Largest Donation of Items by Monetary Value; Recognition of Black Confederates—Second Place; Public Relations—First Place Best PR Report; Historian—Best Chapter Yearbook; and Scholarship—Chapter sponsoring a Division and General Scholarship Applicant.
